# 2019 TEA BLOCK <br> Scrap Happy 

$$
\text { Unfinished size }=121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}
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Finished size $=12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

Center Square: Polka Dot
Surrounding rows: Mixed Scraps of any color Background: White on white

Cut 1 at $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 12 at $2^{1 / 2} \times 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 2 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 12 at $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Half square triangles of mixed scraps and background - Make 8
Cut 4 squares each of mixed scraps and background at $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner on the reverse side of the Background fabric. Place right sides together. Sew a 'scant' $1 / 4$ " on either side of the center line. Cut through both layers of the square on the marked center diagonal. Trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

Method:

1. Sew together half squares triangles to form 4 Flying Geese blocks. Refer to photo for proper orientation.
2. Sew together 2 sets of two $2^{1 / 2}$ " scrap squares and sew onto opposite sides of center square.
3. Sew together 2 sets of four $21 / 2$ scrap squares and sew on the other two sides of the center square.
4. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square to each side of a Flying Geese block, repeat for a second set. Sew on opposite sides of the big square you just made.
5. Sew two $21 / 2$ " background squares to each side of the remaining 2 Flying Geese blocks. Add to opposites sides to complete the Scrap Happy block.
