

# Mystery Block of the Month

## Square in a square Blocks

Cut 6 fabric B squares:  $4\frac{3}{4}'' \times 4\frac{3}{4}''$

Cut 12 fabric A squares:  $3\frac{7}{8}'' \times 3\frac{7}{8}''$

Cut these A squares on the diagonal one time to make 24 triangles.

- Center fabric A triangle along a first side of a fabric B; sew a SCANT  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, press towards triangle.
- Sew next triangle opposite side to the first side, again pressing outward towards the triangle.
- Continue sewing 3rd and 4th triangle to square.
- Trim off tabs and square unit to  $6\frac{1}{2}'$  squares.

Note: You can display a favorite print in the center square or use scraps in the same color way as fabric A triangles.
