

Block of the Month – Mystery Quilt Along

Hi friends,

Come join me on a Mystery Quilt Along. This one is an easy one. Who doesn't like easy? There will be NO appliqué, paper piecing or Y seams. I don't think I can make it any easier than that, unless I tell you what the mystery is. Fat chance!!

When you're done, you'll have a nice lap size quilt about 72 "X 54" and you could make it larger by adding borders.

Let's have fun!!! Only 3 fabric colors are needed. There should be a high contrast between each of fabric colors.

For example:

Fabric A	Fabric B	Fabric C
Coral	Yellow	Teal blue
Pink.	Purple	Yellow
Lt green	Yellow	Red/pink
Yellow.	Black.	Grey
Red.	Tan	Black
Blue.	Off/White	Green



Fabric A: (most color seen and main "design") You will need about 1 ³/₄ to 2 yds; I am being generous in the amount

Fabric B: (background) Choose white, grey, off white, black, tan, yellow or any color you want as background. You will need about 3 yds

Fabric C: (highlight) You'll need about 5/8 - 1 yd, again I'm being generous on the amount. For each of the fabric sets (A,B and C) you may use a single fabric or a combination of fabrics for a scrappy look. For example: You could use a combination of fabrics for A and single color for B & C.

If you have any questions about your choices, come see me. I'll be happy to guide you.

Should you decide to accept this assignment, November and December are quite easy.

For November: We will be making half square triangles (HST) from fabric A & B.

- Cut (12) 4" X 4" squares from A and B.
- With RST draw a diagonal line on the back of either square and sew ¹/₄ inch from both sides of the line.
- Cut in half so you'll have 2 HST measuring 3 ¹/₂" when you are done.
- You should end up with (24) 3 ¹/₂" HST.

Easy peasy!
