
## **BOM MYSTERY QUILT** 2019-2020


## Month #1 - November

- LARGE Part 1 - Button block - 6" W x 6" H - finished (6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished)
- Part 2 Safety pin block 6" W x 6" H finished (6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished)
- Part 3 Star 'A' block 12" W x 12" H finished (12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished)
- Part 4 Half square triangles 3" W x 18" H finished (3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished) \*Each half square triangle is 3" x 3" finished (3 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished)



### Part 1- Button Block (Appliqué)

- Cut (1) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square background piece Use button template below to cut out appliqué for button.
- Use button holes templates below to cut out appliqué for button.
- Appliqué button piece and button hole pieces to background using appliqué method of choice.



### Part 1- Button Block (Pieced)

Cut: A - (4)  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ "

B - (2) 1" x 1 1/4"

C - (1) 2 ½" x 1"


D - (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½"

E - (2) 2 ½" X 6 ½"

F - (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", draw diagonal line on wrong side of (F) square and lay square on each end of piece E and sew on diagonal line.



Sew pieces together as shown. (Pieces will finish  $\frac{1}{2}$ " less than cut dimension.)




### Part 2 - Safety Pin Block

- Cut (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square background piece
- Use safety pin template below to cut out appliqué.
- Applique safety pin piece to background using applique method of choice.








### Part 3- Star Block 'A'

To make (1) unit:

- Cut (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- make (3) half square triangles, each  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Sew (3) half square triangles and (1) square together as shown.


Make (4) units total.



Sew (4) units together as shown.

Block will be 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished (12" x 12" finished)





### Part 4 - Half-square Triangles

Make (6) half square triangles, each 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished (3" x 3" finished)

Sew (6) half square triangles together as shown.
