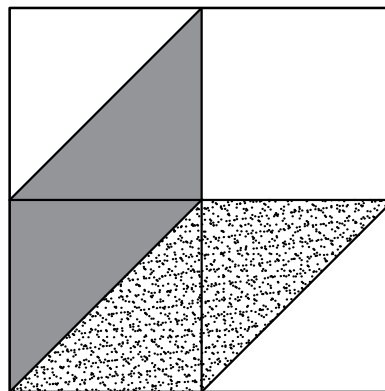
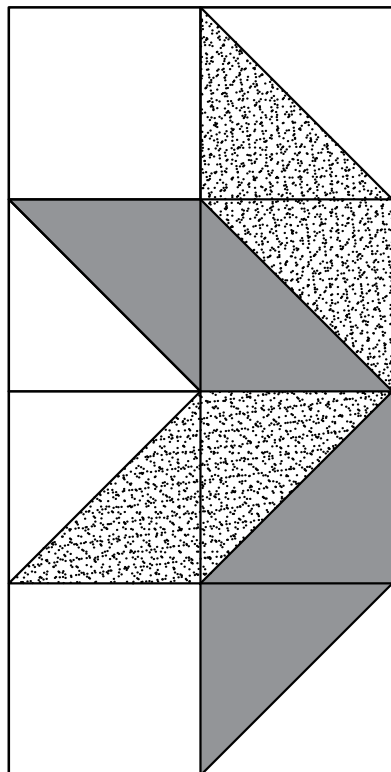
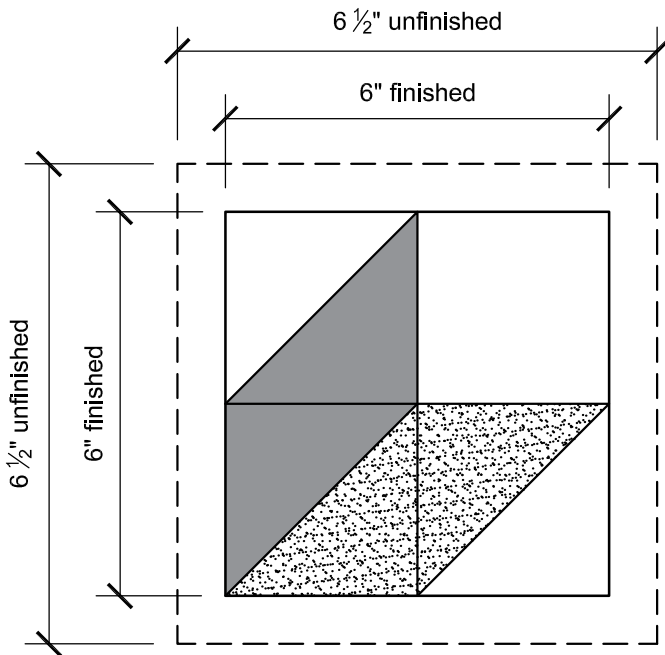
Part 1- Star Block 'A'

To make (1) unit:

- Cut (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- make (3) half square triangles, each $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

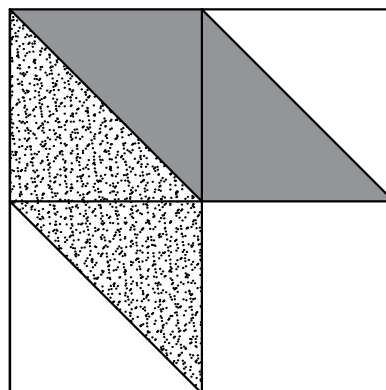
Sew (3) half square triangles and (1) square together as shown.

Make (4) units total.



Sew (4) units together as shown.

Block will be
 $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished
(12" x 12" finished)



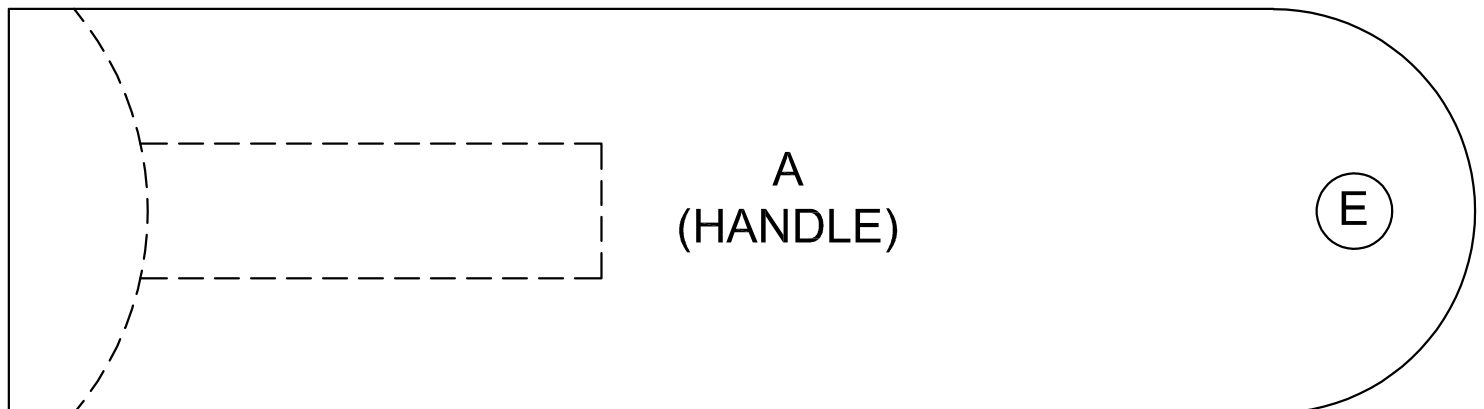
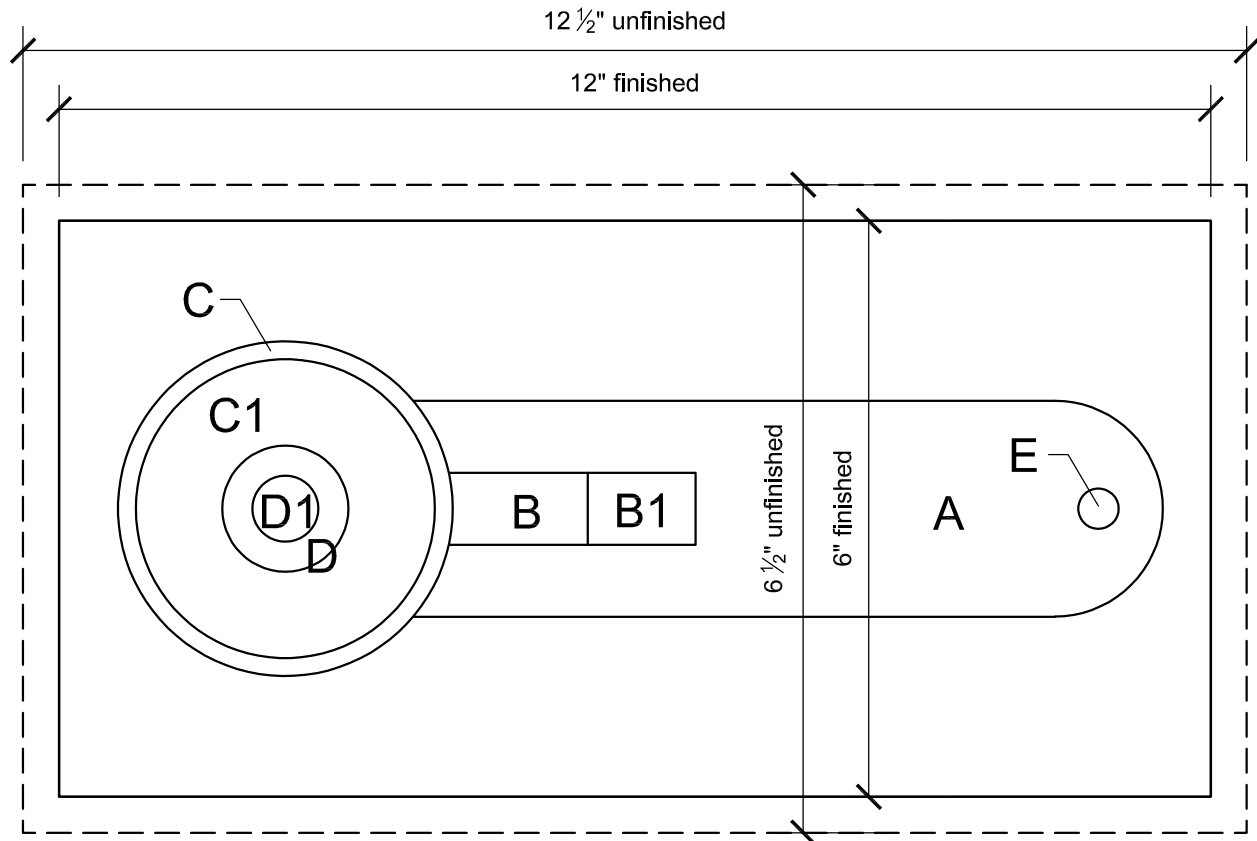

Part 2- Rotary Cutter Block (Appliqué)

- Cut (1) 12 1/2" x 6 1/2" square background piece
- Use rotary cutter templates on next page to cut out appliqué for rotary cutter.
- Appliqué rotary cutter pieces to background as shown using appliqué method of choice.

Part 2- Rotary Cutter Block (Appliqué)

- Use rotary cutter templates below to cut out appliqué for rotary cutter.
- Position/apply piece 'A' (the handle piece) first, then apply the 'B' piece on top of the 'A' piece aligning the dashed curved lines. Then apply the 'B1' piece on top of the 'B' piece aligning the right edges.
- Next apply the 'C' piece on top of the A/B pieces using the dotted line as a guide to position the C piece.
- Then apply the rest of the circle pieces on top of the 'C' piece in this order, C1, D, D1.
- The 'E' can be done several ways, including cutting a hole in the A piece (prior to applying to background!). Or apply another small circle applique piece on top of A or use stitching to make the circle.
