

Loose Threads Quilt Guild 2014 Tea Block

Scraps, scraps and more scraps.... Love to use up those scraps

To make 1 tea block:

Assorted fabric: cut (16-20) $7 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ - $2 \frac{1}{4}$ irregularly shaped strips in assorted colors of red, green, blue, yellow, orange, brown or tan

White on white, WOW: (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 6$ and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ rectangles

DIRECTIONS:

Sew 4-5 assorted colored strips together to form a piece larger than $6 \frac{1}{2}$,

Trim to a 6 inch square.

Repeat above steps to make a total of (4) 6×6 squares

With the stripes facing vertically, join the two squares with (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 6$ WOW strip in between; do this for the other 2 squares,

Finally, connect them with the $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ WOW strip.

This should measure $12 \frac{1}{2} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ square
