Create a strip set from the following:
Red - $\quad 31 / 4$ in ( 3.25 ") wide $\times$ Width of Fabric
White - $\quad 311 / 2$ in $\left(3.5^{\prime \prime}\right)$ wide $x$ WOF
Blue - $\quad 31 / 4$ in ( 3.25 ") wide $x$ WOF
Press seams away from the white strip
Remove selvedges and cut strip set into (4) 9 inch (9.0") squares.
You will have a square left over. (Please bring this to toss into the "Leftovers" box. We will use them to create additional scrappy blocks.)


Cut each square into 2 Half Square Triangles from lower left to upper right.
Be sure that all the squares are oriented in the same direction before cutting. (i.e. red on top)


Sew 2 triangles together to look like this:


Make 2 sets like this and sew them together to make a square that looks like this:
The outside of the block is a bias edge, please starch and stay stitch all around the outside.


Blocks should be 12" unfinished (for an $11 \frac{1}{2}$ in. finished block)
